MORNING AFTER BREAKFAST BLEND

This is our custom English Breakfast Breakfast tea, with the added balance and complexity of whole leaf blend. Every single tea that is part of this blend is a single-origin tea from progressive estates or small farm collectives with ethical practices. It contains the classic jammy malt and tropical fruit notes of a traditional English tea. A dynamic black tea that can stand on its own or take milk and sugar; a proper cuppa.

JASMINE CLOUD

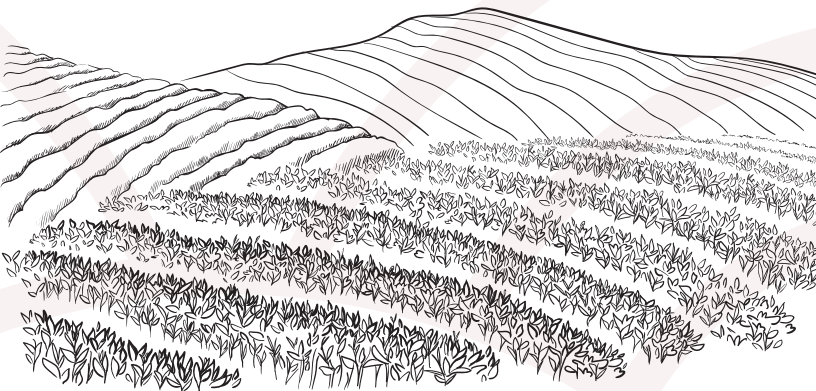
In order to make this classic jasmine tea, green tea is harvested in March, as spring harvests are the most valued. Leaves are plucked, quickly pan-fired, lightly rolled, and then carefully dried. They are then stored until July, when fresh jasmine harvests begin. The tea is blended with fresh harvested jasmine for a whole day. At the end of that day, all of the jasmine flowers are removed by hand and fresh jasmine is added. The green, vegetal flavor gently increases its intensity, right alongside a breeze of jasmine that brings cool midnight air into each sip.



MENG DING GREEN

This legendary green tea is one of China's oldest, first cultivated on the misty slopes of Meng Ding Mountain. Harvested in early spring, the leaves offer a soft, balanced cup with delicate notes of steamed greens, sunflower, and fresh artichoke. Smooth and naturally resilient, it brews beautifully without bitterness and is perfect for slow sipping.





KASTURI

One of the best Darjeeling teas available, with bright, wine-like complexity and floral buzz. This one comes from the Yanki Tea Cooperative. The tea is processed in a similar fashion as estate orthodox teas, but with a focus on a higher quality plucking standard and more uniform processing in the factory. This orthodox tea is as rich and deep as it is effervescent and floral.

EVERSPRING OOLONG

This tea is the work of Grandma Ai of NANTOU, Taiwan. Grandma Ai moved to Taiwan with her family from Fujian Province in mainland China when she was only 7 years old. Since then, Grandma Ai has been working in tea processing. Today she is over 80 years old. Her Everspring Oolong comes from the Si Ji Chun cultivar, the only cultivar native to Taiwan that gives strong harvests all four seasons. The ambient factor, plus the processing, are strictly linked to the taste which shows a refreshing vegetal flavor with hints of sweetness.



CAFFEINE-FREE

MINT BLEND

A cooling, refreshing blend of spearmint and peppermint blended to reinvigorate the taste buds and awaken the senses. The most amazing thing about peppermint from the Pacific Northwest is its liveliness.

One sip will cool your throat and chest breath after breath.

Spearmint offers some of the same cooling, refreshing qualities on the breath as peppermint, but its flavor profile is much sweeter and rounder.

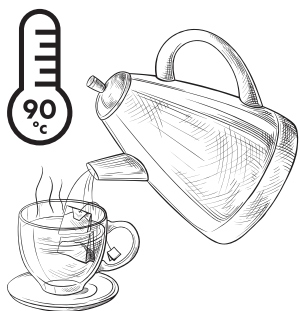


SHEVA HIBISCUS ROSE

This blend got its name from Miami's "Zak the Baker," where this herbal infusion has become a staple. Its tart hibiscus bite and lively mouth feel can turn the corner fast and become a sweet, flowery treat with a bit of your favorite sweetener. Raspberry leaves, rose petals and ginger gives a lovely floral nose but earthy finish.

BREWING THE PERFECT CUP OF TEA

Brewing a perfect cup of tea starts with heating fresh, filtered water to the right temperature. Steep tea leaves in a pre-warmed vessel for the recommended time. Strain and pour into a cup, adding milk, sugar, or lemon if desired. Savor the aroma and flavor of your tea.
